Biogas Plant

A biogas container is an airtight container designed to promote anaerobic material fermentation. Anaerobic digestion (fermentation) is a technique for recycling and treating organic wastes (biodegradable material) that produces high-quality and enriched bio-manure in addition to biogas, a clean and convenient fuel. The mixing tank serves as the biogas plant's input. The biomass and water are combined in this mixing tank to create slurry. Water and cow dung, or biomass, combine to form slurry. The slurry zone is another name for the mixing tank. This sludge next goes into the digester. The digester, which is an airtight chamber, is a place where microorganisms, namely anaerobic bacteria, are present and there is no oxygen present, making it an anaerobic region. These microbes have the ability to break down materials in the absence of oxygen. As a result, the microbes in the digester break down the biomass, or complex material, into simpler components like hydrogen, carbon dioxide, methane, and hydrogen sulfide. When needed, these created gases are removed through the gas outlet from the gas tank where they are kept. A biogas plant was built on the college's campus in an effort to use fewer cylinders. The organic waste from the leftover and expired food from the canteen is fed to the plant. A biogas plant typically produces 2.5 kg of waste, which is then utilized for a variety of scientific applications.

WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES

The following are the water conservation measures provided in institution:

Rainwater harvesting

There is a rainwater gathering system on campus. Rainwater gathered in open spaces with a high run-off coefficient and from the building's roof. The rainwater collected was moved to a percolation tank on the college campus, which was placed in a practical location. Since 2005, the campus has had a rainwater harvesting system. The property has five 5000L tanks located throughout. Plumbing is distributed to the rainwater tank through pipes that are connected to the roof.

Construction of Tanks

Building tops are reserved for retaining water, which is a component of the water distribution system. The everyday needs on campus, including labs, hand washing, cleaning, gardening, and relaxation rooms, etc., are met by the water pumped to the above tanks. The tanks are regularly checked for leaks and obstructions and maintenance is done as soon as necessary.

Campus Water Distribution System and Water Bodies

The campus has a well-established water distribution system with enough amenities to meet user needs. Rainwater is another source of water that is available on campus. Taps are used across campus to distribute water that is pushed to the overhead tanks. A carefully designed network of

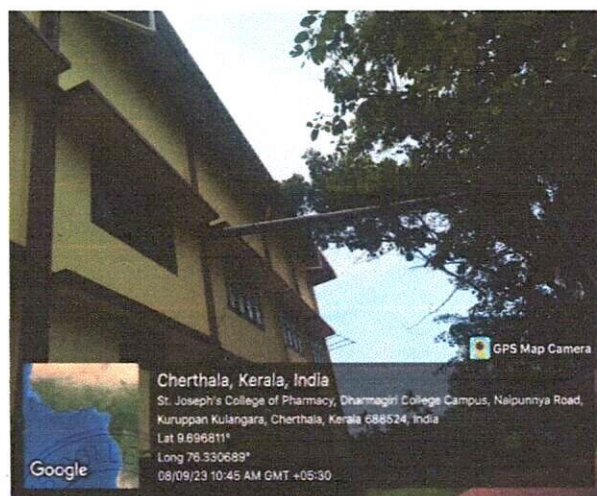
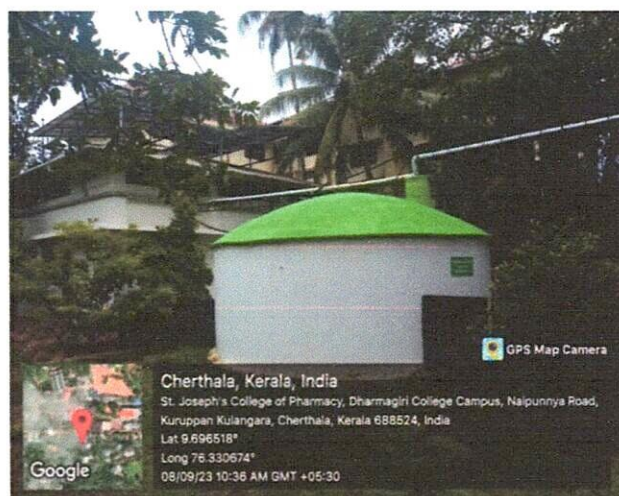

Installation of STP in the college

Sewage treatment plant (STP) (or domestic wastewater treatment) is a type of wastewater treatment which aims to remove contaminants from sewage to produce an effluent that is suitable to discharge to the surrounding environment or an intended reuse application, thereby preventing water pollution from raw sewage discharges.

Biogas Plant

Incinerator

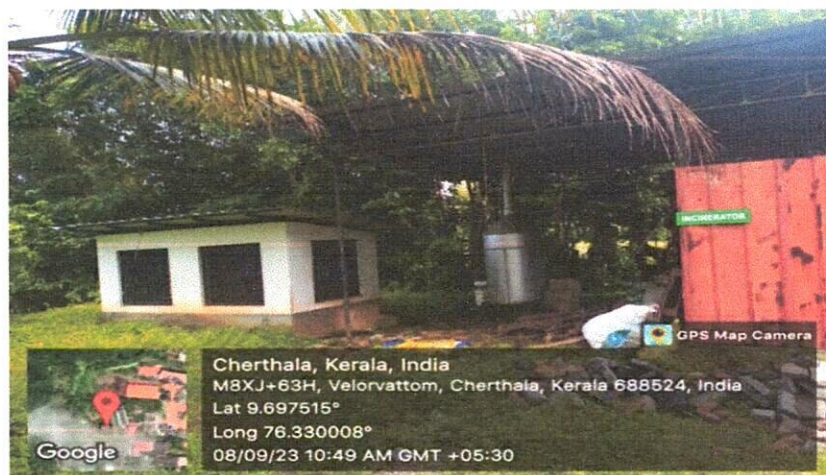

ENVIRONMENTAL AUDITS

Green audit

In India, the concept of carbon neutral campuses is gaining momentum. Green Audit in campuses measures the amount of Green House Gases (GHG) emissions produced as a result of its operations through an accounting like inventory of all the sources of GHGs and carbon sequestration in the school campus. Based on this, the total carbon footprint is estimated. Measures are recommended to bring down the carbon footprint of the campus and to make it a carbon neutral campus.

Energy audit

There is no written energy policy available, but environment policy is available which includes energy conservation also. The management may constitute an energy management policy and display the same in the plant to motivate the staff. Energy Management Cell has to be constituted with an objective to revise action plan for energy conservation thereby reducing the production cost. Energy conservation tips/ posters are displayed in crucial points. Use of renewable energy has to be encouraged.

Environment audit

This section is broken down into the following different areas: waste, water, energy, resource and materials use and procurement. The way communities generate and manage their waste plays an absolutely key role in their ability to use resources efficiently. The effective use of resources can limit its unnecessary wastage. Optimal usage of the resources (such as fuels) can save the fuel and can also reduce the carbon emission due to its consumption. This technique can be effectively implemented in the 'transportation' and 'waste' sectors of the campus.

ALTRUISTIC CONTRIBUTIONS AND MEDICAL OUTREACH INITIATIVES

Objectives

1. To provide financial support to employees
2. To endow contributions to underprivileged households.
3. Lending a hand to society in the midst of a pandemic
4. To provide health awareness among the health public.
5. To support the public by offering various health and hygienic products.


The context

1. Assessing the effectiveness of altruistic contributions and their impact on the community can be difficult but is essential for continuous improvements.
2. Getting resources to where they are needed, especially in remote or crisis-affected areas, can be a logistical challenge.
3. As our college is located in coastal area, the general people lack literacy and are ignorant of the importance of everyday hygiene and health maintenance.

The practices

1. Financial support was provided to the employees especially non-teaching staff who are economically weak. This was provided in the form of fund or soft loan for their house construction, their children's marriage (especially for girl child).
2. Our college also gifted land for two poor families wholeheartedly. One family was gifted with three cent of land and the other family with 4.7 cent.

3. We came up with charity to our neighbours belonging to poor families. An approximate amount of three lakhs was donated to a family with four children (Quadruplets) for their educational support. Apart from that, we had also given fifty thousand rupees, built a toilet facility and compound wall.
4. During 2006 and 2018, the natural calamities like Tsunami and flood hit many coastal areas in Alappuzha district of Kerala. As a part of providing relief for the victims of these calamities, our college organized flood relief camps, food and medical facilities.
5. Since our institution is focused on promoting public health, we decided to prepare hand sanitizer and make the people aware about the proper usage of the same in COVID-19 pandemic. We also provided a quarantine support in association with municipality, Cherthala for four to five months. Ten rooms were made available for this purpose.
6. Covid -19 vaccination camp was conducted at our college in connection with Lourde Hospital, Ernakulam on July 31st 2022.
7. The college also provides financial support to faculties for attending conferences. Students and faculties are provided with funds for the publications in national and international journals.
8. We sought help from some sponsors for endowment of fund to the poor people and deserving students. We got 3.8 lakhs and 5 lakhs from two of our sponsors which were invested in a centralized bank as fixed deposits. 


MANUFACTURING OF HAND SANITIZER DURING COVID-19

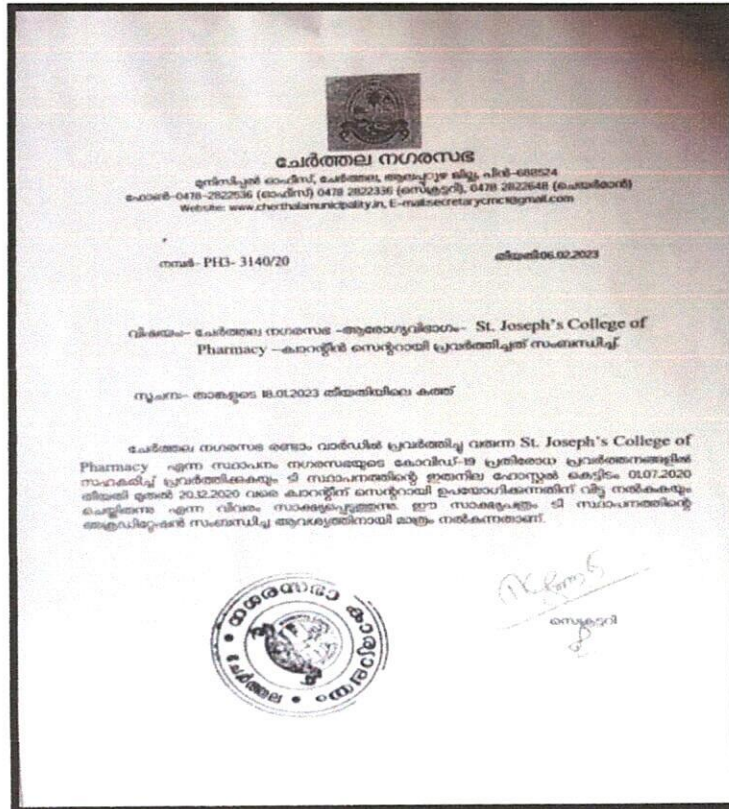

Help from provincial house is Rs. 50,000. The family is supported every month and when ever possible cleaning work is given to the father of the children , now the children are in the 4th standard. We are supporting them since 9 years.

Paper news was given :- One family is giving Rs. 1000 per month , one benefactor can forward given Rs. 50,000 , ie given for education , Treatment and food. Seeing the paper news another agency had deposited an amount of Rs. 3 Lakhs for the education of the children when they are eligible for that.
