Accreditation is now a primary requirement for all HEIs and serves as a yardstick for institutional performance. NAAC is the primary accreditation agency in India. NAAC has changed its parameters and method of assessment in 2017, from a primarily subjective to а predominantly objective assessment system. A high grade accreditation is a testimony for the institutional quality and competence. The teaching and non teaching staffs of the department of pharmaceutical chemistry had played a very active role in the accreditation activities. The department members were part of various committees related to accreditation activities. The sophisticated instruments and machines in the department were given unique codes. Laminated copies of the periodically revised standard operating procedures of the instruments are displayed adjacent to the instruments. The list of experiments are also displayed in the laborataries. Log books are provided so that the operational history of theinstrument can be tracked at a later stage. The faculty members of the department of pharmaceutical chemistry, regularly publishes research as well as review articles in journals of national and international repute. In addition

the members of the department adopts innovative teaching practices like, problem based learning, participatory teaching, self directed learning etc. All the faculty members endorses ICT (information communication technology)enabled teaching methodology. 














Poster presentations of our Pharm.D students during international conference of Clinical Pharmacy CPCON-2025 at Manipal in August 10,2025


