ANNEXURE - 1

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. D. Pharm., B. Pharm., M. Pharm., and Pharm. D., students of all member colleges of KSSPCMA and Government Medical Colleges can participate. In case students of courses other than those mentioned above participate in the competition that particular item of the institution concerned will be cancelled. The institution concerned will not be considered for overall championship.
2. Duly filled online applications for participation in the events must be submitted on or before 25.04.2026. The application shall be authorized by the Principal of the concerned institution in the prescribed online format. Incomplete applications and applications received after this date will not be entertained. The online application link for participation is provided below and will be active from 10.04.2026.

3. A student can participate in a maximum of 5 individual items including off-stage items.
4. From each college, only one student can participate for an individual item and likewise only one team can participate in a group item.
5. At emergency situation, maximum two substitution allowed for group items. It must be approved and attested by the Principal of the concerned college and the hard copy should be submitted to programme committee office before collecting the chest number.
6. Competitions shall be conducted only for the items listed, and the competitions shall be conducted only if a minimum of three participants (or groups) have registered for that particular item.
7. The decision of Judges will be final in all the events. Appeal against Judge's decision will be considered by the *Appellate Committee* by remitting a fee of Rs. 5000 for individual items and Rs 10,000 for group items.
8. Identity card with photograph signed by the concerned Principal is compulsory for every participant. Failure to produce the same at the time of competition will lead to disqualification.
9. Points for each items shall be awarded as follows:

<u>For Group Items:</u>	<u>For Individual and Off-stage Items:</u>
First Prize 10 points	First Prize 5 points
Second Prize 6 points	Second Prize 3 points
Third Prize 2 points	Third Prize 1 point

If a Prize is shared by more than one person or team, each person or team will get the points allotted for that item.

10. Those students who secure the maximum number of points in the individual items shall be awarded the titles 'Pharmacy Kalaprathibha' and 'Pharmacy Kalathilakam'.
11. Overall championship shall be given to the institution which scores the maximum number of points. 10 additional points shall be awarded to the institution in case a student of that institution is awarded the title 'Kalaprathibha' or 'Kalathilakam'.
12. Participants who violate the rules and regulations will be disqualified.
13. Trophy shall be given only to the First Prize Winner. Certificates shall be issued for I, II, and III Places.
14. Videography and Photography shall be the exclusive right of Organising Committee, Pharmolsavam-2026. No institutions/students shall be permitted to take photographs or videos.
15. All participant colleges MUST appoint a Team Manager. The details of the Team Manager including mobile number must be filled in the Registration Form. All communications shall be made through the Team Manager only. The Team Manager must accompany the participants for the programme. In case the Team Manager is replaced due to unavoidable situations, the change must be intimated to all the Committees of Pharmolsavam-2026.
16. Food shall be provided strictly on the basis of Food Coupons, which will be provided by Food Committee.
17. Accommodation and transportation facilities between the venue and the designated place of accommodation shall be duly arranged. Transportation from the venue to the accommodation shall be provided upon the conclusion of the programmes on the first and second days. Transportation from the accommodation to the venue shall be provided prior to the commencement of the programmes on the second and third days.
18. Male and Female students requiring accommodation must be accompanied by Male Staffs and Female Staffs respectively in the ratio of 15:1. Staff members shall be provided accommodation along with students ONLY.

INSTRUCTIONS TO TEAM MANAGERS

1. The *Team Manager* of every participating college shall report to the "*Programme Committee*" Office at 9.00 AM on the first day of Programme with College provided identity card of the participants, signed by the concerned College Principal.
2. Both on-stage & off-stage events begin at 10.30 AM on Day 1.
3. Events for Days 2 and 3 will commence at 9.00 AM.
4. Participants are directed to report to the *Stage Manager* concerned with valid College identity card, one hour before the commencement of the participating event.

Participants without identity card shall not be permitted to participate under any circumstances.

- Participants who fail to report on time will be disqualified.
- Only the concerned College Team Managers are authorized to approach the “*Programme Committee Office*”.
- Food Coupons* shall be issued by the “*Food Committee*”, to the concerned *Team Managers*, in the Programme Committee Office as per the schedule below:

For 1st day: At the time of verification of identity card of participants.
For 2nd day: On 1st day at 5.00 PM – 6.00 PM.
For 3rd day: On 2nd day at 5.00 PM – 6.00 PM.
